He serves as an adjunct lecturer at several universities, where he is actively involved in the training and development of future school psychologists. His past leadership positions within NASP include co-chair of the Social Justice Task Force and African American Subcommittee, chair of the Multicultural Affairs and Social Justice Committees, and Virginia Delegate to the NASP Leadership Assembly.
